SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION

Initiating Catholic Children and Youth into the Sacramental Life

Roman Catholic children may begin to prepare to celebrate the Sacraments of Reconciliation (Confession) and Eucharist (Holy Communion) once they reach the age of seven. Roman Catholic youth may begin to prepare for the Sacrament of Confirmation once they reach the age of twelve in the Archdiocese of Toronto.

Preparing for and celebrated these Sacraments with your sons and daughters is a further initiation into the Catholic Christian way of life: a way of discipleship with the Lord and of journeying together in our shared faith. Reconciliation, Eucharist, and Confirmation form us more and more into the full stature of Christ given to us at Baptism; our baptismal identity is renewed, deepened, and strengthened through participation in these Sacraments. It is not an identity in isolation, but rather one that is characterised by being in relationship with God and all the baptised.

Parents are primary mentors of their children in the way of Christian life: a life marked by worship, mission, charity, community, and prayer in Jesus Christ. This formation occurs primarily at home and is vitally connected to the community of disciples that gathers Sunday after Sunday to encounter the Risen Christ. The Sacraments of Reconciliation, Eucharist, and Confirmation are not "magic moments". Rather, they are unconditional, loving gifts from God celebrated and received within a community of faith. They are given to help us remain close to the Lord and to be strengthened by Holy Spirit as we live our baptismal identity through this community of disciples. They flow from a life-giving relationship between God and us, so that, together, we might live the joy of the Gospel in our homes, our neighbourhood, and our world. We encourage parents to deepen their family's bonds with the Lord and this community of faith through participation in Sunday Mass, especially if they seek to initiate their children more deeply into the Sacramental Life.
