SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION

Sacramental preparation of children and youth for Reconciliation, Eucharist, and Confirmation flows from that first Sacrament which is the gateway to a rich life in God, namely: Baptism. Through the action of the Holy Spirit, the baptized are joined to Christ and transformed into a new creation in which life in Christ *begins*. This new life needs to be continually formed through the community of faith, and, when given in infancy, must be nurtured by parents and godparents, so that the baptized learn to cooperate with the activity of the Holy Spirit throughout their lives.

Further initiation into the Sacraments of Reconciliation, Eucharist, and Confirmation, presuppose that children and youth are already experiencing in their homes and within their parish: moments of forgiveness and unconditional love, encounters with the scriptures, communal and personal prayer, expressions of gratitude to God, and examples of service and charity. These foster a relationship with Jesus Christ. Parents, godparents, and the larger Christian community have a great responsibility to help children and youth develop this relationship with the Lord and to model to them these hallmarks of Christian life; they are the foundations which are transformed through God's grace in the celebration of the Sacraments.

When modelling for children has not occurred and the foundations are not developed, it becomes challenging to initiate children and youth further into the sacramental life. We encourage parents to help their children experience the richness of our parish life, its worship, its community, and its charity whilst (and most importantly) sharing faith at home, especially if they are presenting their children to be prepared for further initiation into Christian life through the Sacraments. The sacramental preparation programs and dedicated volunteers at our parish do our best to provide tools to assist parents so that initiation into Christian life may continue to bear fruit, but we need the cooperation of parents to devote time and energy at home to support the faith of their children from an early age.
